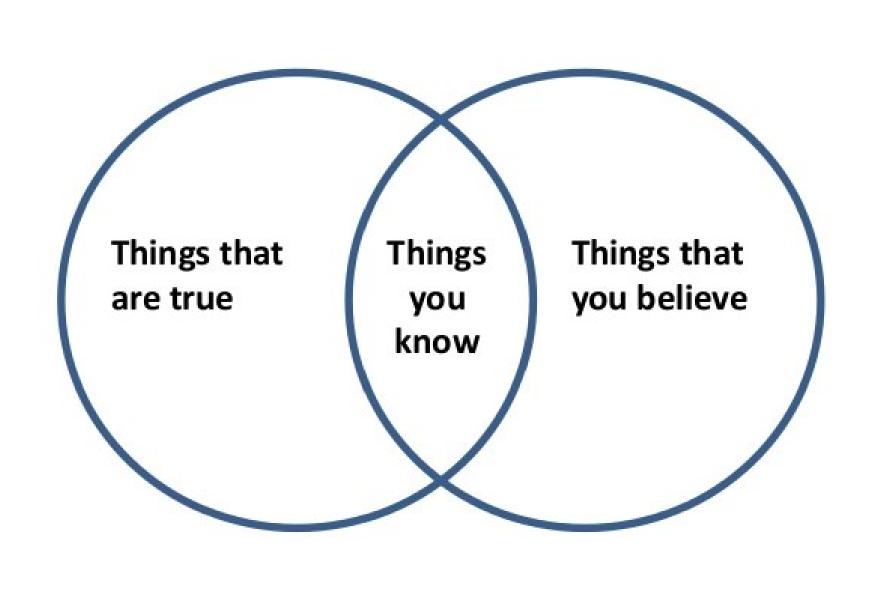
The problem with truthfulness is to be able to be truthful you must perceive the world in its true and actual state.

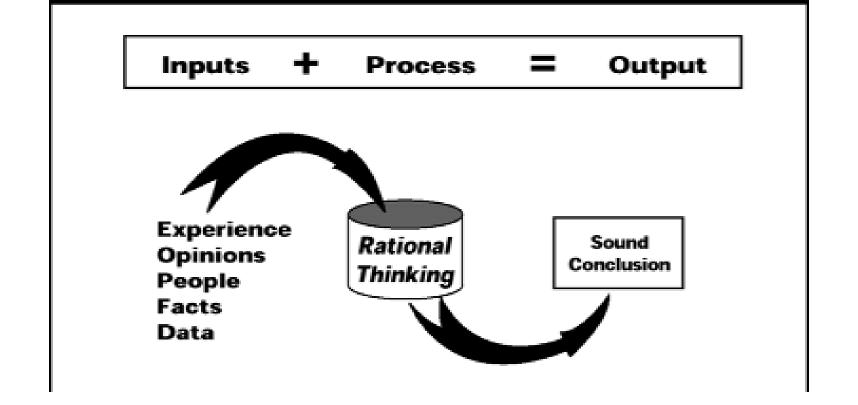

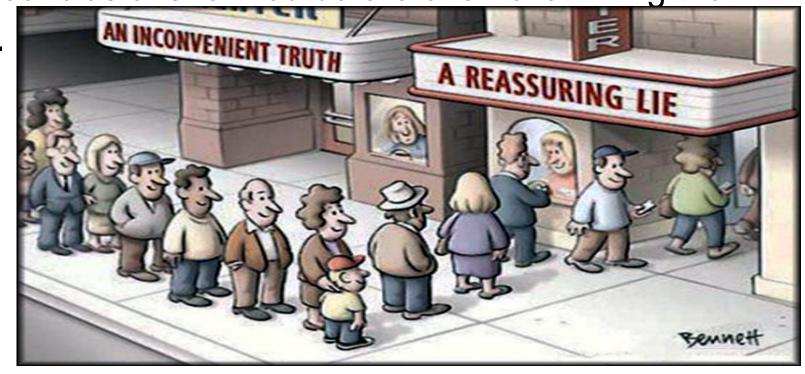
- Acceptance of reality doesn't mean you have to like it as it is,

Why is it so Hard to Accept the truth?



Denial is a defense mechanism of your mind, trying to protect you from what could be an unpleasant realization.

So you avoid negative emotions by not facing your reality. It's easier to look away and pretend everything is fine... for awhile.





How to Accept Your Current Reality

- Do not judge the situation or yourself. Instead know that although it may feel unpleasant for the moment, by accepting reality as it is you are doing the right thing.
