




असतो मा सद् गमय। तमसो मा ज्योतिर्गमय। मृत्योर्माऽमृतं गमय।।





Dīpāvalī" means "a row of lamps" and signifies the victory of brightness over darkness.

The festival is held on "Amāvasyā" or moonless night in the dark half of Kārtik.



Darkness represents ignorance, and light is a metaphor for knowledge.

The origin of Diwali can be traced back to ancient India, when it was an important harvest festival (Śāradīya Nava-śasyesti) around the time of the autumn harvest and the start of the winter sowing.




Farmers give thanks for the bounty of the year gone by.

Later on it was decorated by lighting multiple Diyā - earthen lamps with clarified butter.

This Yajña and the lamps also help clear atmosphere -make free from germs that spread diseases.









One such occasion is considered that Śrī Rāma returned to his kingdom **Ayodhyā** with his wife, Sita, and his brother, Lakṣmana, after several years of exile and defeating Rāvaṇa.


Although according to authentic **Valmiki Rāmāyaṇa**, the correct arrival date is month of fifth day of Chaitra-Shukla.

For Jains, Diwali marks the attainment of Nirvāṇa (final release) or liberation by **Mahāvira** in 527 BCE.


It also marks the end of the year for the Jains.











Swami Dayanand started reformation movement in India in view of degradation of Vedic values and propagation of various myths on the name of dharma.

Child marriage, polygamy, castism,, ignorance towards Vedic scriptures, un-education, poverty, unemployment, superstitions etc. were many evils which were prevalent in his times.





He discouraged dogma and symbolism that run contrary to common sense and logic,

and encouraged skepticism in beliefs.

He taught people to think independently and fearlessly.

He advocated the equal rights and respects to women and advocated the education of a girl child like the males.

He inspired the nation to aspire to *Swarājya* (self governance), nationalism, and spiritualism.

He was the first to give the call for **Swarājya** in 1876, later taken up by Lokmānya Tilak.

He was the first to give the word of *Swadeshi*.



He said; Your ancestors were not uncivilized men living in forests.

They were great men who enlightened this world.

Your history is not a bundle of defeats.

It is the eulogy of the conquerors of the world.



Your Vedic Scriptures are not the songs of cowherds.

They are the immortal truths which shaped mighty souls like Śri Rāma and Śri Kriṣṇa.

Be proud of your glorious history.

Take inspiration from it to mold the present.




The Samyāsī Who Knew No Fear
